Grace Park Use Policy

- 1. Grace Park is available for the public to enjoy Monday-Saturday during daylight hours and on Sunday afternoon and evening.
- 2. The pavilion may be reserved for use by Grace Community Church for use for church functions including weddings and receptions. The Grace Community Church Wedding and Reception Policy must be followed if the park is used for weddings and/or receptions. Any necessary scheduling must be made through the Ministry Assistant in the church office.
- 3. The Park is available for church members or the public to use for birthdays or other events and is available on a first-come, first serve basis. Reservations do not need to be made for these types of events.
- 4. There will be a reservation charge of \$50.00 to be paid when a reservation is made. **Please complete the Facilities Contract.**
- 5. Use of the park may not be for commercial profit unless such use is to benefit the church or community.
- 6. The use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco or other drugs, any form of nudity or use of profanity is strictly prohibited.
- 7. Loud music is not permitted when using Grace Park.
- 8. No activity will be permitted on the church property that may bring disrepute to our Lord or His church.
- Trash receptacles are available and users must clean up after themselves and their pets.
- 10. Use of the pavilion must be limited to 2 hours so that others may enjoy the facility.
- 11. The use of the grills and firepits are prohibited.
- 12. In addition, all posted rules in the park must be followed.
